PETITION FOR ANNULMENT OF MARRIAGE

Petitioner, JESSICA SIMPSON petitions for an annulment of the marriage between the Petitioner and Respondent, DURANGO SIMPSON and states as follows:

1. Petitioner is a resident of Florida and Respondent is a resident of Fort Myers, FL.
2. Both parties are over the age of eighteen.
3. On September 21, 2020 Petitioner and Respondent were purportedly married to each other in a ceremony performed in Fort Myers, FL.
